| Start time | 8.45am Saturday assemble Latrobe Park Scout Hall 10.30am arrive at Yurt Farm for Opening Ceremony |
| Transport | We expect parents who are aren't attending will car pool (via leaders) to get Cubs to and from the Yurt Farm Cubs can come for the day on Saturday but it's a long drive and we encourage everyone to camp! |
| Facilities | Kitchen facilities (2 gas stoves, outdoor BBQ plate). Fire-powered hot showers in bathroom yurt in Yurt village, mobile reception okay. |
| Cost | Yurt accommodation - \$15pp Yurt Saturday afternoon activity - \$12pp Yurt Dinner Sat night - \$8pp Yurt Sunday morning activity - \$12pp Air Scouts providing breakfasts, lunches, morning teas, suppers = \$13pp Total = \$60 for Cubs involved in activities or \$35 for those just staying and having dinner (parents & siblings). Siblings under 6yo are free. |
| Uniform | Shirt, group scarf and woggle Saturday, casual on Sunday |
| Food | Sample menu is as follows, please advise dietary requirements when registering: - Saturday: L= Wraps, D= Spaghetti Bolognese, garlic bread & dessert Sunday: B= Cereal, toast, toad in a hole, L= Sandwiches Morning/afternoon teas/supper will be fruit & cake with cold water/popper/milo, marshmallows at night, damper on a stick |
| Sleeping: | There are 21 Yurts in the village so there will be plenty of room for families. The Yurts are a bit old - this is NOT luxury accommodation they are a bit rough (which is just the way we like it!). BYO sleeping bag, pillow and fitted sheet (there are mattresses provided). One Six per yurt (except girls are in their own Yurt). Cubs must sleep with other Cubs, not with their parents. |

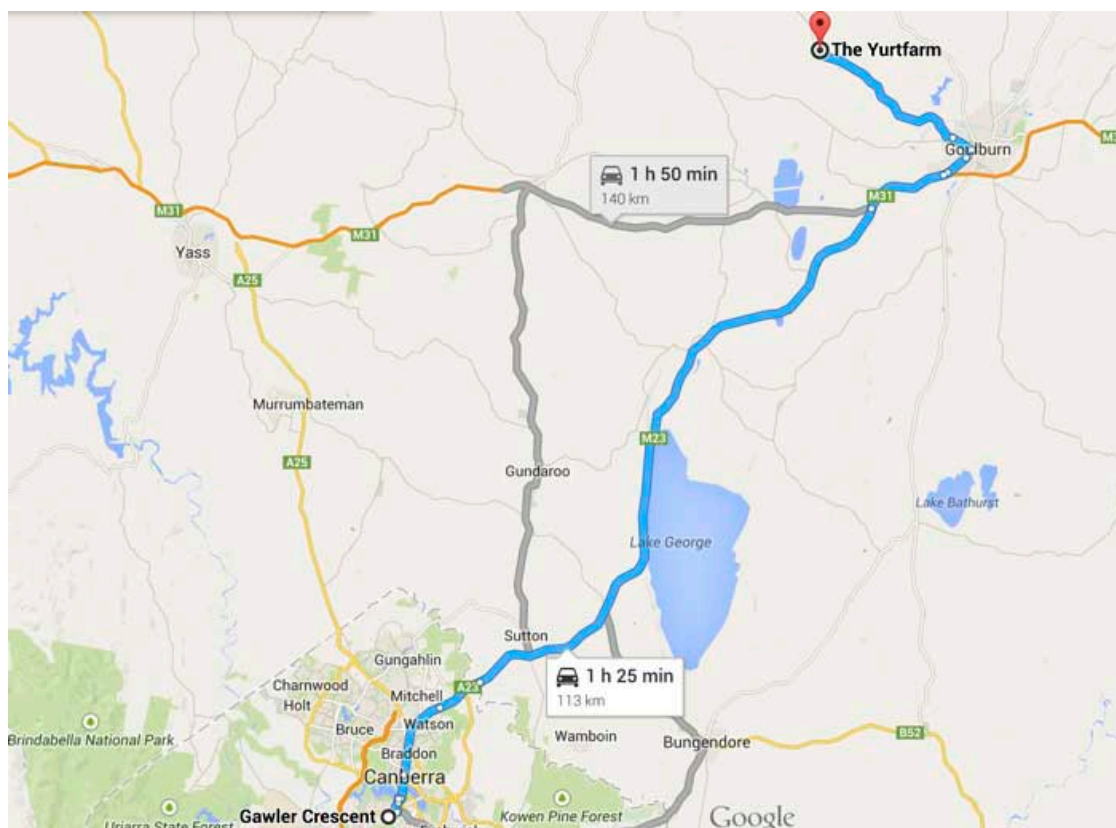

Getting there

The Yurt Farm - 1688 Range Road, Goulburn (16.88km along Range Road)



Route:

1. Follow Federal/Hume Hwy towards Sydney.
2. Take first turn off to Goulburn onto Hume Street
3. Continue along Hume Street (becomes Cowper St) past the Big Merino and Shell service station all the way to the end (approx 4 km)
4. Turn left at the T junction (another Shell service station on the left) into Clinton Street/Range Road
5. Continue along Range Road for 16-20kms - Yurt Farm on right.
6. Once at Yurt Farm: Shortly after turn off there is a gate (please close behind you and secure with rope).
7. Travel approx 2 km down dirt road to Yurt Village. You will pass buildings on right (owner's residence, barn, etc) - continue on dirt road past all of these and through 3 gates (leaving gates as you find them).
